PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP
FOR COLLEGE STUDENTS OF CROATIAN LINEAGE LIVING IN CALIFORNIA**

The President of the Croatian American Cultural Center is proud to announce the offering of scholarship(s) for **2010-2011** year to **graduating high school seniors that plan to attend a two/four year college/university**. This scholarship is also available to students that are currently attending a two/four year college/university and are less than 25 years of age.

The scholarship(s) may vary between \$1,000 and \$5,000 per year. The range of awards is based on a number of variables including but not limited to funding limitations and economic need.

The scholarship(s) are available for the upcoming academic year to students of Croatian lineage with permanent address in California who plan to attend or are currently attending accredited a two/four year college/university or vocational-technical institute on a full-time basis.

The scholarship(s) shall be awarded on the following criteria:

- Croatian lineage
- **Permanent residence in California**
- Minimum High School or College GPA of 3.2
- **Financial Need**
- Not over 25 years of age at the time of application
- **Completed Application and submittal of Personal Statement**
- Proof of College Acceptance or Enrollment (*Not required with application, must be submitted before scholarship funds are distributed*).

Croatian American Cultural Center Scholarship Committee evaluates all Applications using a point system. The scholarship applicants (or their families) who are members of the Croatian American Cultural Center, or involved in activities of the Croatian American Cultural Center will be given an additional (up to) 25 points on their application.


College students can re-apply for scholarship (up to three additional years) provided that they are a full-time student, have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and did not display adverse behavior unbecoming to the Croatian American Cultural Center.

Application deadline is March 31, 2009 and must be met.

Applications are available on the Croatian American Cultural Center website www.cacc.com. web site **Scholarship applications are being accepted from February 1 to March 31, 2010.** The Scholarship Awards will be announced by May 22, 2010 and presented to recipients on June 12, 2010 at the Scholarship Award Ceremony at the Croatian American Cultural Center Extravaganza. The recipients must be present in order to receive the scholarships.

All information about the applicants and the material submitted will be held in strictest confidence.
